## **Admission Plan**

Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology employs a rolling admission policy. Most applicants will receive notification of a decision within three weeks after mailing the application. All parts of the application need to be received before an application can be reviewed for decision.

There are four parts of the application and all must be received before an admission review can take place:

- ▶ **The Application for Admission and Financial Aid**
- ▶ **Request for Transcript and Recommendation** (Submit the attached form to your counselor or teacher. Also, if you have taken any college courses, please submit all college transcripts.)
- ▶ **All SAT-I / ACT results** (Scores present on a high school transcript are acceptable.)

You are also invited to furnish the Admissions Committee with additional information you believe to be supportive of your application. This might include an autobiographical sketch, SAT-II results, your reasons for studying engineering, science or mathematics, a description of a unique experience or an essay about a favorite activity.

## **A Final Word**

While an interview is not required for admission, we enjoy meeting students one-on-one. You are encouraged to visit the campus or to meet with admissions representatives during high school visits, college fairs and regional information sessions. Selecting a college is an important decision and we welcome every opportunity to help you in this endeavor.
