• What is this?

Instead of embedding multiple if statements in our code to check for errors, Java provides the try/catch notation:

```
try {

Blah...

Blah...

Blah...
} catch (exceptionType exception) {

Foo...

Foo...
```

This tries the statements in the try clause, dropping into the catch clause if an exception (error) occurs.
