Men's Basketball Heads to Chicago, Women Head to Wilmington; Swimming Travels to Wabash

The Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology men's basketball team hits the road for one of the nation's premier NCAA Division III Tournaments, while the women travel to a challenging Wilmington Invitational as the winter seasons reach full swing this week.

The men's basketball season team looks to bounce back from a narrow 68-58 loss at Millikin with a trip to the University of Chicago Midway Classic on Saturday and Sunday. The Fightin' Engineers will square off with former Southern Collegiate Athletic Conference rival Southwestern University of Georgetown, Texas, on Saturday. Rose-Hulman returns to action on Sunday with a matchup against either Chicago or in-state rival Earlham College.

Rose-Hulman opens the women's basketball season at the Wilmington College Tipoff Tournament on Friday and Saturday. The Engineers will battle a host Quakers squad picked to finish second in the Ohio Athletic Conference season at 6 p.m. on Friday, then returns to action against either regional power Calvin College or Indianapolis based Marian College on Saturday.

The Engineer swimming and diving teams will also compete this weekend. Rose-Hulman heads to the Wabash College Invitational to square off with several of the top NCAA Division III programs in the Midwest. The Engineers will then return on Dec. 5-6 at the DePauw Invitational, with Rose-Hulman hosting the Engineer Diving Invite on the same two days.

Looking Back at Last Week's Action. . .

Kreipke Narrowly Misses Nationals in Strong Regional Effort

Rose-Hulman junior *Tyler Kreipke (Zionsville)* narrowly missed qualifying for the NCAA Division III Cross Country National Championships to lead the team effort co-hosted by the Engineers and DePauw on Saturday.

Kreipke completed the six-kilometer course in a time of 26:28 to place 20th among 248 runners and earn all-region honors. His effort also marked the fifth best NCAA Division III Regional finish in program history.

Kreipke placed ninth among individuals on teams that did not receive an NCAA Championships bid to narrowly miss the national championship field as the top seven individual runners advanced.

Other key contributors for Rose-Hulman included sophomore *Micah Aldrich (Indianapolis/Warren Central)* in 46th with a time of 27:03; and sophomore *Josh Elkins (Brownsburg)* with a time of 28:23.

Rogers, Clauser Lead Women's Cross Country at Regional

The tandem of senior *Melissa Rogers (Crawfordsville/Southmont)* and freshman *Creasy Clauser (Crawfordsville/Southmont)* paced Rose-Hulman's efforts at the NCAA Division III Regional, co-hosted by the Engineers and DePauw on Saturday.

Rogers came home 51st in a time of 24:04, while Clauser placed 85th of 230 runners in a time of 24:42. Freshman *Katie Ross (Connersville)* added at time of 25:55, and junior *Katherine Quigg (Chillicothe, Ill./Illinois Valley Central)* provided depth with a time of 26:01.

Men's Basketball Falls at Millikin in Season Opener

Millikin University relied on a 16-4 second half run to break open a 50-49 contest and earn a 68-58 men's basketball victory over Rose-Hulman in the season opener for both schools on Sunday.

Sophomore *Jason Haslag (Linn, Mo./Helias Interparish)* paced Rose-Hulman with 17 points for the second highest total of his career.

Freshman *Nate Gissentanner (Conyers, Ga./Rockdale County)* added 15 points on 5-10 from the field in his college debut.

Other key contributors to the balanced attack included freshman *Austin Weatherford (Cicero/Hamilton Heights)* with eight points off the bench; sophomore *Spencer Harlan (Terre Haute/South)* with six points and a team-high six rebounds; and senior *Jeff McCartney (Wooster, Ohio/Triway)* with four points and two assists.

Rose-Hulman earned its largest advantage of the day at 43-38 on three consecutive three-point shots. Weatherford drilled a three-pointer to turn a 38-34 deficit into a one-point game, then Haslag buried a trey at the 15:05 mark to give Rose-Hulman a 40-38 advantage. Sophomore *Blake Knotts (Louisville, Ky./Christian)* then buried a third straight three-pointer as the Engineer lead grew to 43-38 at the 14:21 mark.

Millikin responded with six straight points to regain the lead, before a Gissentanner three-pointer helped tie the score at 47-47, before Millikin's second half run broke open the contest.

Ohio State Tops Engineers at Cook Stadium Rifle Range

The Rose-Hulman rifle team hosted its second home match of the season, but Ohio State University came out with the victory on Saturday.

Senior *Brian Telljohann (Cincinnati, Ohio/Sycamore)* and senior *Lucas Weir (Martinsville, Ill.)* compiled scores of 1,114 to lead the Engineers.

Senior *Eddie Mayhew (Terre Haute)* pitched in with a score of 1,110, with seniors *Derek Adler (Stroudsburg, Pa.)* adding 1,109.

Other key contributors included junior *Parker Lee (Swannanoa, N.C./C.D. Owen)* with a 558 in air rifle and freshman *Katy Dimon (Fairfax, Va./Flint Hill)* with a career-best score of 1,079.

Rose-Hulman returns to action at Akron University on Jan. 16.

2009-10 Rose-Hulman Men's Basketball Preview

Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology looks for a successful blend of youth and experience to take steps forward in the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference this season. The Fightin' Engineers return three starters and seven letter winners from a squad that finished 9-16 last winter.

A pair of honorable mention all-conference award winners lead the Engineer returnees. Sophomore *Blake Knotts (Louisville, Ky./Christian)* averaged a team-high 11.5 points per game and ranked ninth in single-season school history with 61 three-point field goals. Knotts also contributed 2.0 assists and just over one steal per game. Senior *Jeff McCartney (Wooster, Ohio/Triway)* joined Knotts on the honorable mention all-league squad. McCartney poured in 9.9 points per game and buried 41 three-point field goals.

Sophomores *Spencer Harlan (Terre Haute/South)* and *Jason Haslag (Linn, Mo./Helias Interparish)* will contend for significant frontcourt time as returnees. Harlan scored 4.6 points with 3.8 rebounds per game, and Haslag led reserves at 5.9 points and 2.8 boards per contest.

Senior *C.J. Tuskan (St. John/Marian Catholic)* and junior *Steve Ricks (Pittsboro/Tri-West)* will share time at the point guard position. Ricks scored 1.4 points per game, while Tuskan had 1.2 points per contest last winter.

Sophomores *Zach Kleman (Mansfield, Ohio/St. Peter's)* and *Eric Weathers (Indianapolis/Beech Grove)* gained experience in the Engineer frontcourt last year and will provide depth this season. Kleman appeared in six contests with four rebounds, and Weathers appeared in three games last season.

The roster also includes eight newcomers. Guards *Julian Coleman, Nate Gissentanner, Austin Weatherford* and *Eric Windham* join frontcourt players *Brenton Balsbaugh, Jon Gerken, Jordan Nielson* and *Evan Sanders* in the group battling for time.

2009-10 Rose-Hulman Women's Basketball Preview

The Rose-Hulman Fightin' Engineers look to take a step forward with a retooled roster that combines youth and experience for the upcoming 2009-10 campaign. Rose-Hulman looks to qualify for its sixth conference tournament in the past seven years with a roster highlighted by one of the top scorers in the HCAC and the single-season school record for blocked shots.

Sophomore *Alisa Dickerson (Elizabethtown, Ky./Elizabethtown)* earned a spot on the league's all-freshman team and emerged as one of the most consistent scorers in the HCAC last winter. Dickerson averaged 10.3 points and 6.6 rebounds per game on 47% shooting from the field. Her efforts included ranking second on the team in assists (76), steals (37) and blocked shots (21), while playing both at the point guard and small forward positions.

Junior *Donna Marsh (Mobile, Ala./Baker)* ranks second in career school history with 134 blocked shots in just two seasons as a Fightin' Engineer. Marsh set a school record with 76 blocked shots last season to surpass her previous single-season mark of 58 set as a freshman. Offensively, Marsh averaged 7.2 points per game and led the team with 7.3 rebounds per contest.

Junior *Eli Baca (Santa Fe, N.M.)* paced the Engineers in assists in her first season of extensive action. She averaged 5.9 points, 6.1 rebounds and 3.8 assists per game while joining Marsh in recording the first triple-double in school history during an overtime win over Lake Forest last season.

Junior *Nicole Klass (Evansville/North)* provides a steady perimeter shooter to the rotation. Klass scored 4.5 points per game and paced the squad in three-point field goals (22) and free-throw accuracy (85%) during her first significant playing time.

Junior *Rebecca Bowermaster (Wood River, Ill./Roxana)* rounds out the returnees. Bowermaster offered post depth last winter with averages of 2.1 points and 1.9 rebounds in 20 contests that featured four starts.

The Engineers welcome four newcomers to the fold. Freshmen *Arielle Mabon (East Chicago/Central)* and *Kim Handoko (Jakarta Selatan, Indonesia)* provide depth on the perimeter, with freshmen *Erin Davey (St. Charles, Mo./Incarnate Word Academy)*, and *Paige Klemme (Greenfield/Central)* gaining time in the frontcourt.
