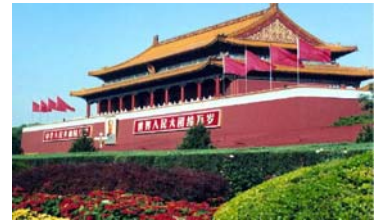


Comparative Politics (GS 161)
