Fellows in the
Rose-Hulman Distinguished Teaching Fellow Program
to begin
Fall 2016

Rose-Hulman's reputation for excellence in undergraduate math, science, and engineering education stems directly from the caliber of its faculty and staff and their dedication to learning new ways to improve our students' education. We invite you to join us as one of the Rose-Hulman Distinguished Teaching Fellows: we will gather new teaching ideas from you and you will learn new approaches by immersion at Rose-Hulman. We envision an opportunity for mutual intellectual exchange, where your experiences and our culture come together to create something better.

Rose-Hulman Distinguished Teaching Fellows will be experienced faculty who wish to spend up to a year at Rose-Hulman teaching and exchanging ideas on teaching with our faculty. The appointment will include a half-time classroom teaching component as well as opportunities to engage with our Institute-wide Center for the Practice and Scholarship of Education. In addition, Fellows will play a role in crafting the program for future participants.

Rose-Hulman Distinguished Teaching Fellows will be selected through a national search. They will be capable of teaching foundational classes in our mechanical engineering department but need not be currently teaching in mechanical engineering; in future years the program will be expanded to include other areas of expertise. Fellows will generally be tenured faculty on sabbatical from their home institutions and may begin as early as Fall 2016. Fellows may apply to spend one, two, or three quarters in residence, or may apply for the full year (three quarters + summer). Fellowship stipends will be commensurate with experience and a half-time teaching assignment.¹ More information on Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology is available at www.rose-hulman.edu.
