Understanding Financial Aid:

What is Course Program of Study (CPOS)? Course Program of Study (CPOS) is a federal requirement that only courses that count toward a student's program of study (your declared major/minor) be considered when determining Federal and State of Indiana Financial Aid eligibility.

What type of financial aid does CPOS impact? CPOS only applies to Federal and State of Indiana Financial Aid (e.g., Pell Grant, SEOG Grant, Stafford Loans, PLUS Loans, 21st Century Scholars, Frank O'Bannon and State Incentives). It does NOT impact eligibility for institutional financial aid (e.g., Rose-Hulman Merit Scholarships and Grants).

How do I know if I am impacted by this rule? Students will receive an email letting them know that they are considered less than full time because of their courses are not counting towards their degree. Students should reach out to the Registrar's Office to get their courses updated.
