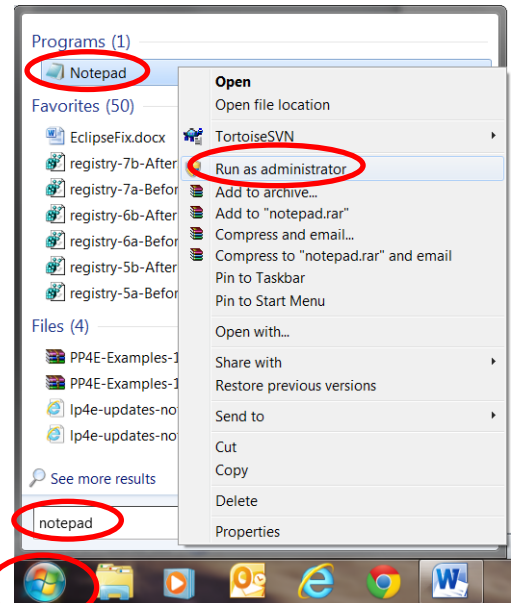
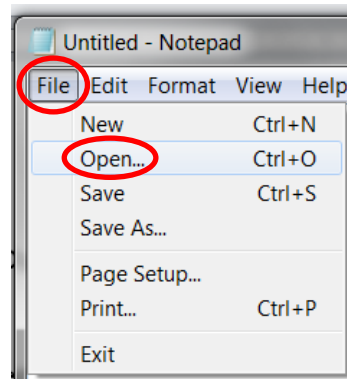


A workaround for an error in our installation of Eclipse

1. Find **Notepad** from the Start Menu.
2. Right-click on it and select **Run as Administrator**.
3. If asked to do so, enter your **localmgr** username (`. \localmgr`) and password.



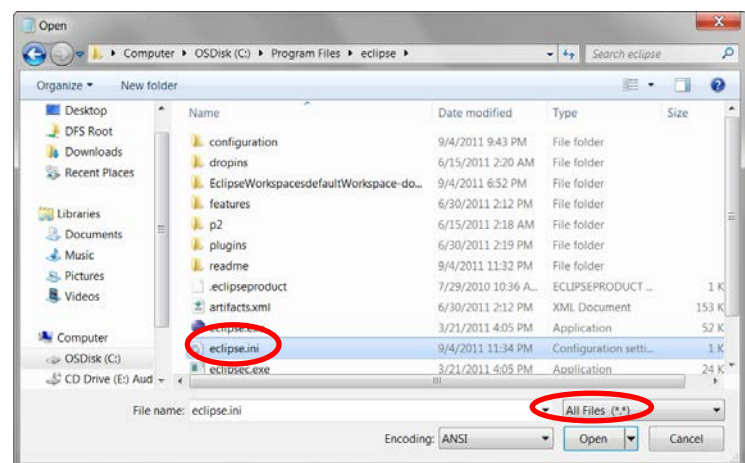
4. In Notepad, select **File ~ Open**



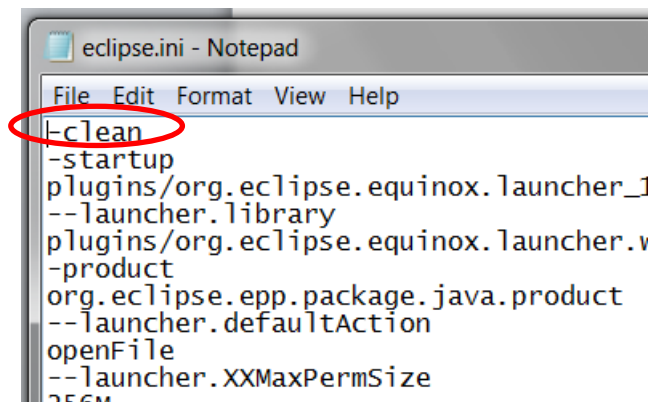
5. Browse for the file:
C:/Program Files/eclipse/eclipse.ini

You will need to change from **Text Documents** to **All Files** in the lower-right of the dialog box to make this **.ini** file visible.

6. Select **Open**.



7. Put **-clean** as the **first** line of that file (leaving the other lines unchanged). The file should then look like the picture to the right (just check that the first two lines are as shown).



8. Select **File ~ Save** and then exit Notepad.
