1. In a version control system like SVN:
 - a. What do we call the copy of the data on the **server** (that contains all previous versions as well)?
 - b. What do we call the copy of the version of the data on **your own computer**?
 - c. What command do we use to acquire the data from the repository the **first** time?
 - d. What command do we use to send our working copy, after it has changed, to the repository? (More precisely, this command sends just the changes, not the entire document.)
 - e. What command do we use to acquire an updated version of the data, after teammates or other people sharing our repository have modified the data?
