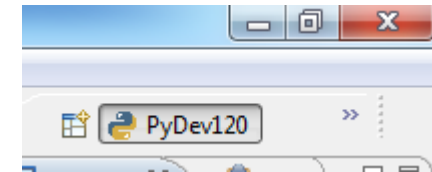
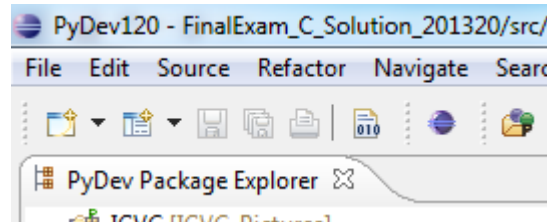
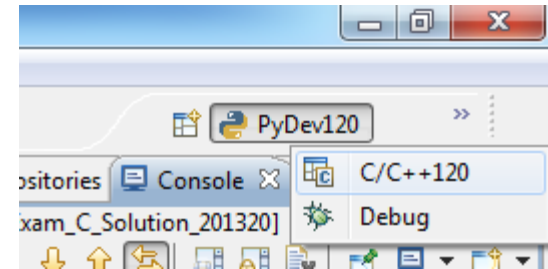
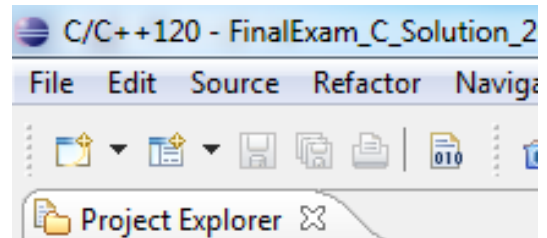




- Be in *Python 120 Perspective* for Python



and *C/C++ 120 Perspective* for C.



In C:

- Use the hammer  before EACH run .
- You cannot run if there is **red** in ANY of the files of the C exam.
- Warning messages are almost always really indicators of an ERROR in your code in C.
- If you have **Permission Denied** messages, you are running the program in the background (accidentally). One way to kill such is to do Control-Alt-Delete to enter Task Manager, select the Processes tab, and look for a process whose name begins **FinalExam_C_....** Then select the process(es) and choose **End Process**.
- Commit often.
