Students,

Welcome to Piazza! We'll be conducting all class-related discussion here this term. The quicker you begin asking questions on Piazza (rather than via emails), the quicker you'll benefit from the collective knowledge of your classmates and instructors.

- Ask questions** when you're struggling to understand a concept—you can even do so anonymously.
  - "Anonymous" means anonymous to your classmates. The instructors will always see the poster's name.
- Answer questions** too!
  - The instructors can (and will) correct any answer that is not quite right, so no worries.

To get started using Piazza, **DO the following 3 items:**


**Step 1: Read the *Welcome to Piazza! (Tips)* @1** (follow the link) if you have not already done so.

**Step 2: Practice ASKING questions** by following the instructions for **How to ASK a question @20** (follow the link).

- It can be ANY question that you like! (But keep it G-rated, please.)
- Be sure to put your question in the **sandbox folder for your section**.

**Step 3: Practice ANSWERING questions** by following the instructions for **How to ANSWER a question @21** (follow the link).

- Select the **sandbox folder FOR YOUR SECTION** to see all the questions that your classmates have asked.
- Choose a question in that folder that has NOT yet been answered if you can, but it is also OK to do a follow-up to a question that has already been answered.



**What is the best way to learn...**

One question above has Student and Instructor answers, and another has just an Instructor answer. The bottom question has NO answers yet -- it would be a good one to choose.

Enjoy! Just make sure that you **ASK a question** and **ANSWER a question**.
